Cookie guidelines:

Acceptable types of cookies: oatmeal, peanut butter, chocolate chip, molasses, ginger, lemon. Cookies that are uniform in size (no larger than 2 1/2 ") pack best and resist breakage. **Very important: NO** icing, sugar toppings, sprinkles, fruit, powdered sugar or any coating/glaze on outside of cookie. Use creamy peanut butter in PB cookies.

Place baked cookies in clear bags and, if possible, in a box to prevent breakage during transport. Cookies can be made ahead and frozen. Please **pray** for the people that will receive them while you prepare them.

Agape guidelines:

Agape can be handwritten notes, letters, cards, paper placemats, posters or artwork on plain paper with **NO glue, stickers, glitter, or adhesives of any kind (incl tape).** No maps of any kind. If you want to sign your name, use **FIRST NAME ONLY**; do not use any other identifying personal information. If you put Agape in envelopes, please **DO NOT SEAL THE ENVELOPES.** Keep all Agape upbeat and positive. Children's artwork is very moving.
